LCCA works to promote the civic and social interests of residents by:

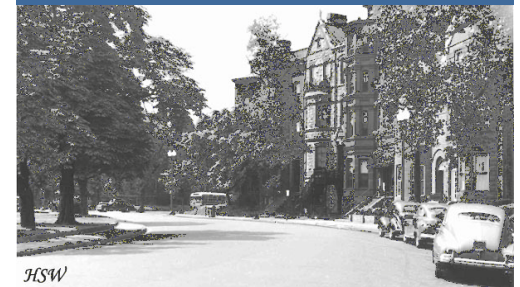
- *Enhancing the quality of life and promoting economic development.*
